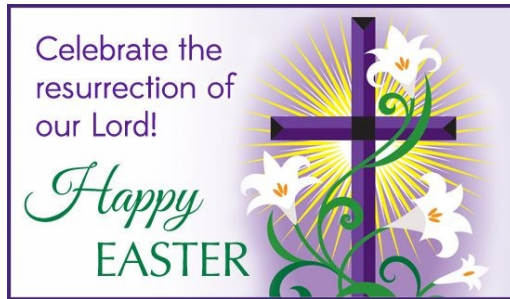


Greetings in the name of Jesus.
